

Figure 1.5. R&D spending, selected countries 2000–2015;







Prominence of research from China





Chinese Doctorates Expected to Grow Dramatically


Science & Engineering Doctoral Degress Awarded by Country

- Articles should be:
 - within journal scope
 - interesting to readership
 - the appropriate scientific quality
 - novel and advance existing knowledge of subject



Choosing a journal

- Journal scope?
- Specialised or General journal?
- Communication or a full paper?
- Impact factor
- Publication times
- Society Publisher?




Writing the paper

- Think about audience
- Keep the language simple
- Use short sentences and short words
- Use spell and grammar check
- Proof read before submission
- Emphasise novelty and impact
- Compare with existing work and reference related articles
- Follow the Journal guidelines

Peer review

- Suggest referees
- Referee selection considerations
 - Specialist knowledge
 - Speed and reliability
- Referee's role
 - Comment on science
 - Make recommendation
- Editor's role
 - Consider the referee reports
 - Make decision

Revision and Acceptance

Revision:

- Respond to all reviewer comments
- Give details if you disagree
- Ensure answers are included in article
- Itemise all changes in your letter
- On acceptance:
 - Edited by a team of professional staff
 - Help with English language
 - Proofs
 - Check meaning and understanding
 - Check references, figures and content
 - Publication on web as soon as possible

Tips to get published

- Read and follow the Guidelines for Authors
- Include thorough literature search
- Keep the language simple, short sentences
- Proof read before submission
- Suggest referees
